Did You Know:

Scouts account for:

- 64% of Air Force Academy Graduates.
- 70% of Naval Academy Graduates.
- 72% of Rhodes Scholars. (worlds most outstanding students)
- 85% of F.B.I. Agents.
- 26 of the first 29 US Astronauts.
- Of the 12 men to physically walk on the moon's surface, 11 were involved in Scouting.

- 94% of the men who were members of the Scouts as youth agree that Scouting helps develop character.
