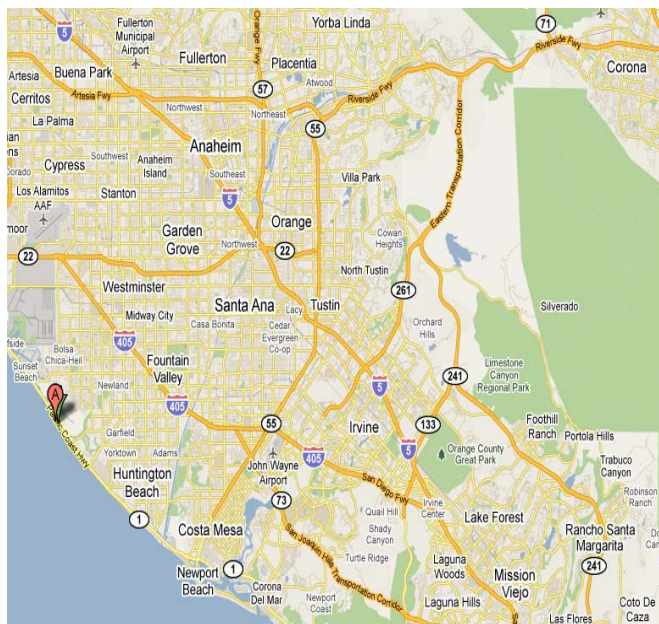
-About 8 or so miles north on PCH 1 you will find Bolsa Chica State Beach on the left side of the road.
