Pack 29 “Fellers” Cake Bake Rules

1. Cakes should be brought to the February 26th 2011 Blue and Gold Celebration held at Agate Park.
2. Cakes must be baked by a Cub Scout or Webelos Scout with male assistance (father, brother, uncle grandfather, neighbor, friend). No female assistance is allowed, but they are allowed to sit back and laugh!
3. The cake and icing may be store bought or made from scratch.
4. The entire cake creation must be edible, including all decorations.
5. Naming your cake is optional
6. Try to keep with the theme of the event: Old Fashion Family Values
7. Might be a good idea to put the cake on a disposable tray.
8. The cakes will be logged in before the start of the Pack meeting. Cakes will be numbered and put on display for judging purposes.
9. All cakes will be judged by the Pack Committee and awards will be given in the following categories:
 - Best Tiger Cake
 - Best Wolf Cake
 - Best Bear Cake
 - Best Webelos I Cake
 - Best Webelos II Cake
 - Cubmaster’s Choice
10. Cakes to be auctioned off or eaten.
