Camp Wiley

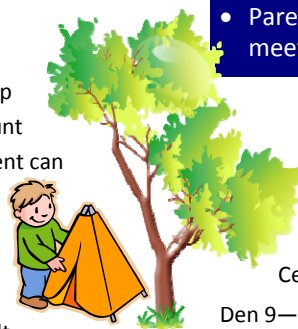
Summer Camp Wiley is coming up and we need to get our head count to hold our spot. Scouts and Parent can attend camp.

☞ The fleur-de-lis (or flower) has been used as a decorative design or symbol for ages, and is also the main symbol used in the Scouting movement. Baden-Powell originally chose this symbol because it resembled the arm-badge that soldiers known as "Scouts" wore in the British Army.
