When and Where is it?

The event will run from Friday October 15, 2010 to October 17, 2010. All attendees will arrive at Troop 201 Scout House, B Street Chino and 11th Street, at 6:00 pm. All Scouts and Webelos are to be in Class "A" uniform. The group will depart to Canyon RV Park, leaving the Scout House at 7:00 pm Friday evening and returning around 12:00 noon Sunday.

The event is being held at Canyon RV Park 24001 Santa Ana Canyon Road, Anaheim, CA 92808.

What is It?

The purpose of Webelos Weekend is to introduce Webelos, their parents and leaders to Boy Scouting. The program is designed to create in all Webelos a genuine desire to know more about Boy Scouts. Webelos will learn about Boy Scouting from Boy Scouts. Webelos will be assigned into patrols with experienced Boy Scouts and their patrol leaders. Webelos will participate in the various activities including camping overnight with their patrol.

The Activities for Webelos will include Map & Compass, Outdoorsman, Outdoor Cooking, Fire Building / Safety, Knife & Ax Safety, Campsite Setup, Capture the Flag and Tug of War. There will be an evening campfire, and of course, the overnight camping.

Meals, Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner and Sunday breakfast are included in the fees. Meals will be cooked and served outdoors style, bring your mess kit.

The Cost

The fee is \$10.00 per person if paid by October 11, 2008. After October 11th the fee will be \$14.00 per person. The cost includes meals, patch, program supplies and insurance. We cannot guarantee space for participants if not registered by October 11th.

WEBELOS WEEKEND RULES

TROOP 201

In the good old Scouting spirit, we ask that all Webelos Scouts, parents and leaders accept the following standards as a guide to good clean, safe living at camp.

1. Candles are not allowed at camp. No flames of any kind are allowed in the tents. This includes lanterns and smoking materials.
2. Adult tobacco use is allowed only in the designated smoking area.
3. Please remain quiet between Taps and Reveille. No scout is permitted outside of his own campsite after Taps without approval and accompaniment of his leader.
4. **NO ONE** should leave Camp without checking out with a Troop 201 Leader, except after closing ceremony on Sunday.
5. Hazing or initiations will not be tolerated. Scouting must be a 'safe haven' for boys where they will feel emotionally and physically secure from abuse or undue stress. They must learn the value of respecting the feelings of others at all times.
6. Please use the restrooms for their intended purposes and please leave them clean. Garbage bags may be obtained from a Troop 201 leader.
7. Should you come across a situation where the health and/or safety of a camper is at stake, take immediate action even if the camper is from another unit.
8. The leaders should remain with their groups at all times. Packs splitting up for different activities or other reasons should send a leader with each group.
9. The buddy system will be used at all times. At no times should an individual Scout be found on his own in camp.
10. Upon your departure, you need to police your campsite, placing all garbage and trash in your garbage bag. You should then take your trash to the Troop 201 equipment trailer.
11. **Drugs:** Only those prescribed by a physician should be brought to camp. All drugs must be registered with the Troop 201 designated person and be kept under the control of an adult Pack or Den leader. Illegal drugs, the misuse of other drugs or substances, or alcohol will not be tolerated. Violators will have to leave camp.
12. Each Webelos Unit or Pack will be responsible to file their own **Tour Permit**.
