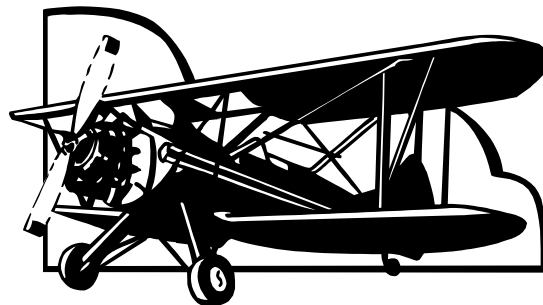


BSA 100 Fly-Over Photo Shoot
